Vendor/Dealers must report to Joann Rorick for space assignment prior to setting up their display. No dealer is permitted to set up without a signed contract. Vendor/Dealers who have not returned a contract before July 13, 2019 will be provided space on a first-come, first-served basis. Vendor/Dealers are required to remain setup until Sunday, August 18, 2018, 3:00 pm and to clean up their area before leaving. Drive-in Vendor/Dealers are always welcome. Maumee Valley Antique Steam and Gas Association assumes no responsibility for the Vendor/Dealer complying with the Indiana State Tax Laws or Merchant's requirements. A camping fee will be assessed to dealers after 5:00 p.m. Monday, August 19, 2019. Pre-packaged foods and fresh produce may be sold. Selling any type of drinks or concession-type food is prohibited. No alcoholic beverages permitted. Inappropriate items and behavior will not be tolerated and you will be asked to leave. Pets must be on a leash and not allowed to be in contact with the public. All pet owners shall be responsible for clean-up of all pet droppings. If cancellation notification is not given before August 13, 2019, any deposits will not be returned.

Please consider this letter your special invitation to participate in our 42nd Annual Summer Tractor and Engine show, August 15-18, 2019. This show is sponsored by the Maumee Valley Antique Steam and Gas Association east of New Haven, Indiana. We will be featuring International Harvester Tractors, Gas Engines, Garden Tractors and Trucks. A special feature is the International Scout that was built in Fort Wayne plus lawn and garden tractors. All other exhibitors are also welcome.

The show includes exhibits of the following: antique cars, trucks, steam engines, gas engines, tractors, garden tractors, crafts, parts vendors, flea market and a quilt display. The following activities are conducted during the show: Sawmill operation, shingle mill operation, threshing, plowing, and a blacksmith shop. The Dekalb County Horseman will be providing rides Friday and Saturday and the Flying Circuits will be conducting daily model airplane flying demonstrations. The 765 Nickle Plate Steam train Museum will have a open house Saturday and Sunday one mile north-east of the show grounds.

Display spaces are 20' X 40' for \$60.00 With no electricity and \$70.00 with electricity. Electric hook-ups are limited and will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Insurance is required or you can purchase coverage. Returning your contract early will assure you the space you request.

The park grounds will be open at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, August 13, for exhibitor/vendor set-up. On arrival, please register at the Main Office. Exhibitors/vendors are required to remain set up until Sunday, August 18, at 3:00 p.m. and to clean up their area before leaving. Show hours on Thursday, Friday and Saturday are 9:00 a.m. - 9:00 p.m. and from 9:00 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. on Sunday.
